TEXAS GEAR

BRAND COLORS

The **GU Brand Colors** are meant to be bold and bright, providing a focus on the vivacity of youth in education.

The **GU Brand Colors** may be used in any combination, as long as graphics, type and design retain proper visibility. It should be the decision of the designer on how to make the **Brand Colors** work best within the design of the material.

White or **GU White** should be used as the background color on designed materials, however other **Brand Color** options may be used when **GU White** is not applicable.

The **GU Black** color should be used as black on designed materials. The color #000000 should never be used as black.

The **GU Logo** should never be used in any distinctive colors other than **GU White, GU Yellow, GU Green, GU Blue, GU Purple, GU Grey, GU Black** or any percentages of these colors.



BRAND COLORS RATIONALE

There are some things to consider and avoid when using the **GU Brand Colors**:

GU Blue, GU Purple, GU Black and GU White should be the primary colors used when designing.

GU Blue and **GU Purple** take precedence over any other colors. They are often used for main graphic elements, and for headlines and subheads in typography.

GU Green should be used as a secondary color, and used to add another dimension to **GU Blue** and **GU Purple**. It should be used as a design accent color for graphics, and important information in typography.

GU Yellow is a nice highlight color and should be used sparingly. Avoid using **GU Yellow** on a light background.

GU Grey should onle be used as an accent color to **GU Black**.



TYPOGRAPHY

The **GU Typography** style is designed to evoke a youthful energy, in an effort to engage students and pique interest in the Texas GU program.

Axi is used for headline type. The font is only used in all-caps format.

Headline Two is used for sub-header type, should always appear below the headline. Font can be used as largest type on page if a headline does not exist.

Crush Smooth is used for title type, and should appear below the headline and subheader type. Font can be used as largest type on page if a headline or subhead does not exist.

Trade Gothic Light (LT) is used for body copy type only.

Amatic is used for youthful call-out type, and should only be used along with icons, images or other graphic elements. The font is only used in all-caps format.

The **GU Triple Stack** logo consists of three graphic elements:

TEXAS – first line GEAR – second line U Arrow and Texas P – third line

The **GU Triple Stack** logo should appear on designed materials only in the styles seen here.

The correct color combinations for use on white and dark backgrounds are as follows:

White Backgrounds:

TEXAS - GU Purple GEAR - GU Blue U - GU Black P - GU Green

Dark Backgrounds:

TEXAS - GU Yellow GEAR - GU Blue U - GU White

P - GU Green

LOGO: GU DOUBLE STACK

The **GU Double Stack** logo consists of four graphic elements:

TEXAS – first line GU Lines – first line GEAR – second line U Arrow and Texas P – second line

The **GU Double Stack** logo should appear on designed materials only in the styles seen here.

The correct color combinations for use on white and dark backgrounds are as follows:

White Backgrounds:

TEXAS - GU Purple GEAR - GU Blue U - GU Black P - GU Green

Dark Backgrounds:

TEXAS - GU Yellow GEAR - GU Blue

U - GU White

P - GU Green

LOGO: GU GRANT

The **GU Grant** logo can be used as either a Triple Stack or Double Stack logo.

There are eleven GEAR UP grants in Texas as of 2014. Each grant is a stand-alone program responsible for driving a college-andcareer-readiness culture in their community.

The eleven grants are:

- Bryan ISD
- Region One ESC
- UTEP Proyecto M.A.S.
- UTEP SOAR
- Creating a Vision IV
- East Texas
- GU2
- ESC Region 12
- IDEA Public Schools

Grant-specific logos should only be used at the grant level, not at the state level.

The **GU Badge Brand Mark** should appear on designed materials only in the styles seen here.

The correct color combinations for use on white and dark backgrounds are as follows:

White Backgrounds:

BADGE - GU White TEXAS - GU Purple GEAR - GU Blue U - GU Black P - GU Green

Dark Backgrounds:

BADGE - GU Black TEXAS - GU Yellow GEAR - GU Blue U - GU White P - GU Green









BRAND MARK: TEXAS GU

The **Texas GU Brand Mark** consists of three graphic elements:

Texas Shape G used in logo U Arrow

The **Texas GU Brand Mark** should appear on designed materials only in the styles seen here.

The correct color combinations for use on white and dark backgrounds are as follows:

White Backgrounds: TEXAS SHAPE - GU Black G - GU Green U - GU Blue

Dark Backgrounds: TEXAS SHAPE - GU White G - GU Purple U - GU Blue









BRAND MARK: U ARROW

The **U Arrow** brand mark consists of two graphic elements:

Circle Shape U Arrow

The **U Arrow Brand mark** should appear on designed materials only in the styles seen here.

The correct color combinations for use on white and dark backgrounds are as follows:

White Backgrounds: CIRCLE - GU Black U - GU Yellow

Dark Backgrounds: CIRCLE - GU White U - GU Blue
